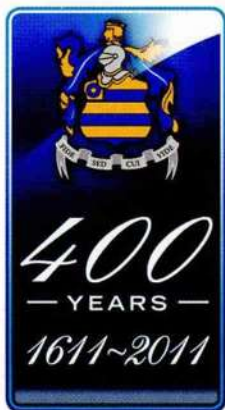

This year the School proudly celebrates 400 years in Oldham. The opening of Oldham's original Grammar School took place in 1611, built on half an acre of land in the middle of Oldham given by James Assheton of Chadderton. By the 1860's this school had fallen into a state of neglect and disrepair and was closed down. The Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools – one for 250 boys and the other for 150 girls – were established in 1895 using some money held in trust from the sale of the old building in 1869 and a capital sum of £18,000 from the Hulme Trust Fund.

William Hulme was a Lancashire gentleman and landowner who died in 1691 without a direct heir. In his will he bequeathed the rents of certain lands to fund the maintenance of four poor local scholars at Brasenose College, Oxford. By the mid nineteenth century this fund had increased so much in value that it was decided by the Hulme Trustees and Charity Commissioners to use a substantial amount of the money for the provision of university and grammar school education in Lancashire. In 1881 a scheme was approved to build and endow schools at Manchester, Bury and Oldham in addition to making grants to the Victoria University of Manchester. From the outset it was the intention of the Commissioners to use the money for the education of young men and women.

An eight acre site on the brow of Chamber Hill was chosen at a cost of £5,400. The foundation stone was laid on 13 September 1893 and the Schools finally opened by Earl Spencer on 30 May 1895. For reasons of financial economy the boys' and girls' schools were built together but with separate classrooms around one large central hall intended for common use. Fees were fixed at £8.8s per annum and the school opened with 48 boys and 29 girls.

Many changes have occurred over the years: notably the building of the new school for the girls in 1925, boys' science laboratories in 1959, a second floor extension built above the original main buildings in 1991-93, together with the acquisition of nearby houses and the construction of the sports hall, swimming pool and the Brierley Art Studios. In Autumn 2008 a new chapter opened in the life of Hulme. Thornycroft had been completely refurbished to accommodate our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children. This move to Thornycroft provided our younger children with modern high quality facilities within a splendid Victorian building. Autumn 2009 heralded the day when the Nursery children could also move to this fabulous site and their bespoke accommodation. The development of Hulme Kindergarten has substantially underpinned the foundations of Hulme. Another important project was the restructuring of the Chamber Road entrance in 2010 to create a new Reception and Administration Office; these facilities dramatically enhanced our service to the Hulme community.

Since 2006 the schools have been organised under one umbrella and the leadership of a Principal. Hulme now has a distinctive structure: at the nursery and sixth form ends of the spectrum the educational experience is fully co-educational, whilst the 7 – 16 year old pupils benefit from being taught in single-sex classes yet are able to mix socially and share extra-curricular activities. Our Kindergarten, Preparatory School, Senior School and Sixth Form work together to provide a cohesive family atmosphere and consequently our children are happy, confident, successful and well nurtured individuals.

The Oldham Hulme Grammar School has been fortunate over the years to secure support from many local families - whether they have been founders, benefactors, governors, parents, pupils or committed teaching and support staff - who have been crucial to its longevity and success. We look forward with optimism to the future.
