The House Names and the Needham Trophy

Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools' four houses are named after the founders and benefactors of the Schools. Pupils and staff belong to one of the four houses and each term points are collected by boys and girls in recognition of their wide range of academic and extra-curricular activities undertaken within the School. At the end of the academic year all the House points are added together and the overall winning House is presented with the magnificent Needham Trophy.

Assheton

In 1606 James Assheton of Chadderton died and in his will he gave half an acre of land in the middle of Oldham to build a grammar school for the town. The new school opened in 1611. Children were "to be instructed in the English, Greek and Latin tongues, and with good manners also". By the 1860's the original Oldham Grammar School in Peter Street had fallen into a state of neglect and disrepair and was closed down. Money from the sale of this building in 1869 was used to establish the new Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools in 1895. There are reminders of the 1611 School in the present day building on the Chamber Road site. On the back drive opposite the New Hall there is the stonework from the original doorway set into the brickwork of the wall of the school, and on the main staircase the original stone mullioned windows have been set into the wall, together with a photograph of what Oldham looked like in 1875.

Hulme

William Hulme was a Lancashire gentleman and landowner who died in 1691 without a direct heir. In his will he bequeathed the rents of certain lands to fund the maintenance of four poor local scholars at Brasenose College, Oxford. By the mid nineteenth century this fund had increased so much in value that it was decided by the Hulme Trustees and Charity Commissioners to use a substantial amount of the money for the provision of university and grammar school education in Lancashire. In 1881 a scheme was approved to build and endow schools at Manchester, Bury and Oldham in addition to making grants to the Victoria University in Manchester. From the outset it was the intention of the Commissioners to use the money for the education of young men and women. In 1887 a grant of £18,000 was given by the Hulme Trust for land, buildings, fittings and furniture for the Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools – one for 250 boys and the other for 150 girls on the same site on Chamber Road. The present Schools were opened by Earl Spencer on 30 May 1895.

Lees

Sarah Buckley from Mossley, later known as Dame Sarah Lees, was married in 1874 to Charles Edward Lees a member of the wealthy cotton spinning family who owned Hope Mills at Bottom of the Moor, and large houses in Werneth Park, Oldham and at Lancaster Gate in London. With the death of her husband in 1894, Sarah and her two daughters worked hard giving dedicated service to the town and Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools. In 1907 the ratepayers of Hollinwood elected Sarah Lees as the first Lancashire woman councillor. She represented the Hollinwood ward as a Liberal councillor until 1919 and became the first woman to become Mayor of Oldham and to receive the Freedom of the Borough in 1910. The Lees family were interested in educational matters in Oldham and played an important role in the newly established Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools. Mr C E Lees was appointed the first Treasurer to the Governors in 1887 and later Dame Sarah became a Governor of the Schools (1893-1935). Their daughter Miss Marjory Lees followed her parents' example and became a member of the governing body herself in 1909.

Booth-Platt

Mr Hesketh Booth, clerk to the Oldham magistrates, was a member of the committee set up in 1884 to prepare a scheme for the Oldham Hulme Grammar Schools. He was one of the deputation who went to London to discuss the scheme with the Charity Commissioners. Later, as a member of the Sites Committee, Mr Booth was one of five men who decided that the schools should be built on part of the Chamber Estate, and arranged for the purchase of eight acres on the brow of Chamber Hill in what was then a rural part of Oldham. Mr Hesketh Booth became Treasurer, Hon Clerk and Vice Chairman to the Governors before retiring from these posts in 1918.

The Platt family owned Platt Brothers and by the end of the nineteenth century they had become the largest engineering and textile machine making company in the world. By the early twentieth century the company employed 15000 workers with three collieries, 65 acres at Hartford Works in Werneth and 20 acres at Greenacres. The Platt family served their native town well over several generations, becoming Liberal Members of Parliament, Councillors, Mayors, High Sherriffs and prominent members of society. It is also interesting to note that Platts have a part to play in the origins of the Toyota car company. In 1929 Platts bought the patent for a loom from Toyoda Automatic Loom works in Japan. The money received for this was given by Sakichi Toyoda to his son Kiichiro who was interested in developing automobile manufacturing. The first type A engine was created in 1934, the Toyota Motor Company in 1936, and the rest as they say is history!

The Needham Trophy

The Needham Memorial Trophy is awarded to the winning house in the House Competition. This elegant trophy was presented to the Oldham Hulme Grammar School by Keith Needham (who attended the school between 1900 and 1904) in memory of his father, Sir George W Needham (a governor of the school between 1902 and 1928) and his brother Lieutenant G G Needham who attended the school between 1904 and 1907. Sir George was born in Oldham and at the age of 16 joined Platt's as a junior clerk, remaining with the company for his entire career and rising to become Chairman and a Director of the business. He was a governor of the Oldham Royal Infirmary for 35 years and gave an endowment to the hospital in memory of his son, George. George Geoffrey Needham joined the 1st Battalion The Lancashire Fusiliers and died of wounds received at Suvla Bay at Gallipoli in Turkey on 22 August 1915. Lieutenant Needham had been awarded a Military Cross and the family home was at 'Holly Bank', Werneth, Oldham.
