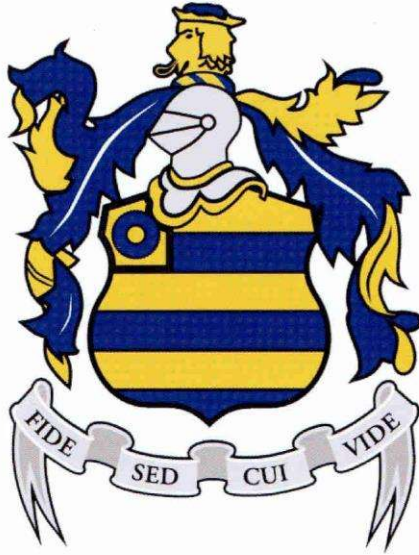

PROGRAMME

One Hundred and Twenty Years of Outstanding Education in Oldham, 1895 – 2015

This year marks the 120th anniversary of Oldham Hulme Grammar School. On 1st May 1895 the doors opened to the first pupils, 48 boys and 28 girls between the ages of eight and sixteen. A further 74 boys and 58 girls joined the school in the following academic year.

Since the demise of Oldham's original grammar school in the centre of town in 1869 due to the dilapidated state of the 250-year-old building, the apathy of the trustees and the desire of the Corporation to redevelop that part of the town centre, advanced education was no longer available in Oldham. The land and buildings were sold to the Corporation for £1010.

However, owing to the determination of certain 'men of vision' in Oldham and the shrewd investments made by the trustees of the old school, grammar school education in Oldham did have a future. The 1869 Endowed Schools Act (which provided for the use of obsolete charities to fund new educational schemes) and the Elementary Education Act of 1870 (under which school boards were formed in every municipal borough), inspired Mr Joseph Travis JP and Mr Hesketh Booth, Clerk to the Oldham Borough Justices, to investigate the possibility of founding a new grammar school for Oldham. Significantly, the new school would be for both boys and girls.

It took 25 years for their plans to come to fruition but they persisted in their claim for funding from the Hulme Trust, drawing up the scheme in 1884 and obtaining approval from Her Majesty the Queen in Council on 28th November 1887. The will of William Hulme of Kearsley (1631 - 1691) had made provision for income from his estates to be available for the benefit of schools in the areas around Manchester. The successful application for funding effectively established the continuity between the Oldham Grammar School and the new Hulme Grammar School (Oldham).

The first Governors' meeting took place in Oldham Town Hall on 27th December 1887 but a further six years passed before permission was given for building to start on the eight-acre site on Chamber Road. This land had been purchased from the Chamber Hall Estate at a cost of £5,400; a further area of 8544 square yards adjoining the site was given to the school by Miss Dorothy Lees.

Oldham-based architect John Whittaker Firth was appointed to design the building and the foundation stone was laid on 16th September 1893 by Mr Joseph Travis. Chamber Road was little more than a track at this time and the new school would be situated in open countryside beyond Chamber Colliery; Windsor Road, Frederick Street and College Road did not yet exist. The original plans show eight classrooms designated for boys, plus a 'chemical laboratory' and 'chemical lecture hall' (situated in the area which is now the main entrance, reception and offices), and five classrooms for girls. Each classroom originally had a tiered floor (as found in a lecture theatre), gas lighting and open fireplaces. Some of these features remained in place until the 1960s. The basement would contain the heating chamber, a gymnasium to be used by both schools, plus separate dining rooms and recreation rooms for the boys and girls. Separate entrances were provided; the girls' entrance is still in use today but the boys' entrance, while still visible from outside, is no longer utilised due to changes to that part of the building. The foundation stone is now on an interior wall due to extensions to the building.

After the official opening ceremony performed by the Right Honourable Earl Spencer, the Oldham Chronicle praised the finished building thus: "... placed upon the southern brow of the hill on which Oldham stands. It is beautiful for situation, and will long form a landmark for miles of surrounding country. Its truly handsome hall and its delightful corridors and classrooms are charming embodiments of the beneficent spirit which directed the mind of William Hulme in making his bequest."

The children who arrived at school for the first time on Wednesday 1st May 1895 were greeted by their headmaster Mr Samuel Ogden Andrew, a local man in his late twenties who had been educated at Manchester Grammar School and Oriel College, Oxford, where he had gained 1st class honours in Classics, and their headmistress Miss Alice Foxall (also in her late twenties), born in London and

educated at North London Collegiate School for Girls and London University where she was awarded an MA in Philosophy. They were supported by a small staff of well qualified graduate teachers and together set the foundations for the school's ethos and academic excellence, values still held by today's school. Subjects offered to pupils alongside the 'three Rs' (Reading, Writing and Arithmetic) included English Grammar, Composition and Literature, Mathematics, Latin and Greek, French and German, Geography and History, Religious Instruction, Natural Science, Drawing, Drill and Gymnastics, and Vocal Music.

While many of the children lived within walking distance of school (two miles was considered a reasonable distance for a child to walk to school a century ago), some came from further afield such as Shaw, Ashton and the Saddleworth villages, being transported by rail from the 25 stations within the school's catchment area to Oldham's stations - Clegg Street, Central and Werneth - all of which were about three-quarters of a mile from school.

Both the boys and the girls were encouraged in extra-curricular activities ranging from the debating societies and literary club to the production of the school magazines - The Oldham Hulmeian and The Hulme Victorian. For the girls, regular Saturday trips with members of staff to local places of interest or into the Saddleworth countryside were positively anticipated. Most of the children attending Oldham Hulme Grammar School in the early years had previously been privately educated because little beyond an elementary education had been available in Oldham. Many of the girls had been educated at home. For both boys and girls, attending Oldham Hulme Grammar School during the last century provided opportunities for a successful future which, had the school not existed, many would never have been able to achieve.

This year also marks the 90th anniversary of the Girls' School Extension. By the end of the First World War demand for places at school had increased significantly. Two public spirited gentlemen, Mr Harold Cliff and Mr Jesse Thorpe, organised a collection of £50,000 to keep both schools at Chamber Road and, with an initial donation of £3000 from the Master Cotton Spinners' Association, the funds were soon raised by the wonderful generosity of the people of Oldham. Plans were drawn up and throughout 1924 building work progressed. An extension of three floors to the original building would be for the girls' school and give them ten new classrooms, an art room, sewing room, laboratories, and a hall to be used for assemblies, drill and dancing. Most of the original school building was given over to the boys' school, thereby increasing the capacity of both schools. Built into the side of the extension, the door from Oldham's original grammar school would be preserved.

The new girls' school was opened on 21st May 1925 by the Earl of Crawford and Balcarres in the presence of Lord Emmott, Dame Sarah Lees and Dr Phoebe Wilson.

The school archive team, all retired volunteers, have enjoyed another busy and successful year. We have produced three small exhibitions which have been displayed in the reception area. The first of these depicted the contribution of old boys and girls during the First World War. The second focused on the top two classes of the Boys' Intermediate School which were evacuated from occupied Guernsey in 1940 and were given space in our school for the next five years. The final exhibition commemorated the 120th anniversary of school. All of these appear, or will soon appear, on the archive website.

Transcription of the original school registers up to 1928 is now complete and will also be available on the website later this year.

Ongoing projects include the scanning of school magazines (of which we have a complete collection spanning 120 years), interviewing old boys and girls about their time in school for our audio archive, and continuing to catalogue the many thousands of items in our collection.
